Curriculum Policy

[Master's Program]

- 1. To provide education that cultivates research and practical skills to actively address problems and issues in the field of nursing and midwifery practice
- 2. To broaden students' perspectives, and provide them with in-depth academic knowledge, by arranging a group of ingenious subjects that support the major. These include subjects that promote the deepening of general nursing knowledge, as well as those related to theories and skills of adjacent sciences, and high professional ethics
- 3. To promote the acquisition of specialized research skills in the education and research field of the major by arranging subjects such as master seminars, master seminar practices, and research for thesis (Master's Thesis Course)/research project product (Certificated Nurse Specialists Course and Advanced Course in Midwifery). In addition, students can take elective subjects in fields other than their major to acquire a wide range of specialized knowledge and the ability to think flexibly.

 \langle In the Master's Thesis Course - Nursing and Midwifery \rangle

• To train outstanding nursing and midwifery professionals, educators, and researchers in the field of education and research, by encouraging them to pursue the theory and practice of nursing and midwifery based on the actual conditions of health and welfare of diverse people, as well as to acquire the ability to actively respond to the needs of society.

 \langle In the Certificated Nurse Specialists Course \rangle

• To train professional nurses, who will provide high-level nursing care to individuals, families, and groups with complex and difficult-to-solve nursing problems, and who will respond to the advancements in advanced medical care, by arranging a group of subjects that deepen knowledge and skills in specific professional nursing fields.

 \langle In the Advanced Course in Midwifery \rangle

- 1. To enable students to acquire outstanding abilities and play a role in the midwifery field, which requires a high level of specialization, by arranging a group of subjects that are applied and developed in midwifery, such as exploration of the theory and practice of midwifery, outstanding midwifery skills, practice in international activities, etc. The course specifically provides education to develop both research and advanced practical skills to meet social needs in the field of midwifery, such as issues that hinder the health maintenance and well-being of women and their families, mothers, and children.
- 2. To provide those, who have completed the nursing education program, with a group of the foundation subjects required for midwifery license. Specifically, to provide education

to deepen the learning of basic midwifery, perinatal care, and women's health support.

Diploma Policy

[Master's Program]

In the Graduate School of Nursing's Master's Program, students will be approved on completion, and the degree of Master of Science in Nursing will be awarded to those, who are recognized as having the following abilities:

1. Students must understand human dignity, have a broad perspective, and possess profound academic knowledge.

2. Students must possess a high level of professional ethics, contribute to the development and exploration of nursing and midwifery, and have the ability to contribute to health, medical care, and welfare.

3. Students who complete the Master's Thesis Course (Nursing and Midwifery) should have the research and practical skills to actively address problems and issues in their major field of education and research.

4. Students who complete the Certificated Nurse Specialists Course should have outstanding abilities in practice, consultation, coordination, ethical coordination, education, and research in the specific field.

5. Students who complete the Advanced Course to train advanced-level midwifery practitioners should have advanced midwifery practice and research skills.

6. Students who complete the Course for Qualification Acquisition for the National Midwifery Examination should have basic midwifery practice skills and research skills as midwives.

7. Students must have the research ability required for the master's thesis or research project product, which is appropriate for the master's degree in terms of: research purpose (problem statement), research methods, implementation, analysis, appropriateness of discussion, potential for academic development, ethical considerations, etc.
